AGE GROUP Ages 2 - 7

The Teacher's Materials pack contains complete instructions for taking the students step by step through a service, beginning with the vesting of the altar and learning about the cross, candles, flowers, and symbols. The children learn when to stand, sit, and kneel, and how to follow a service in a service book (which they themselves make). There are also instructions for making the altar vestments and other items, which can be done if time permits. We recommend ordering one set of Teacher's Materials (A1-TP00-98) for each teacher in the class.

The Student Materials pack supplies the students with colored pages for The Children's Service Booklet, ready for them to make and use. Versions are available for the 1928, the 1979 Rite 1, and the 1979 Rite 2 Services. Order one Student Materials item for each student.

GOD SHOWS US THE WAY

Teach the Ten Commandments using the Lives of the Apostles as Examples of real Christianity

In the context of the Apostles' lives (who they were, what they did, including many legends about them), the students learn about the moral universe God created for our protection. Students are presented with the choices they too must make in order to follow God.

AGE GROUP Ages 7 - 12

This is currently the earliest course in the Teal Curriculum which includes Question Review Cards for the playing of various games. Instructions for the games are included. Beginning in about 2nd grade, students can really enjoy a rousing review game using the facts they have learned in the preceding sessions.

Children use and keep booklets called God's Way or Ours which contain the most important information from each lesson. These are illustrated with jingles and drawings of (rather humorous) young people, families, and others who seem to have some trouble keeping the Commandments. The Handout Sheets give the students the opportunity to learn about each Apostle through his shield of symbols. This is usually so interesting that people have been known to hang onto these shields into adulthood. A parish in Michigan has a set the children made of wood, beautifully painted, displayed in the Parish Hall!

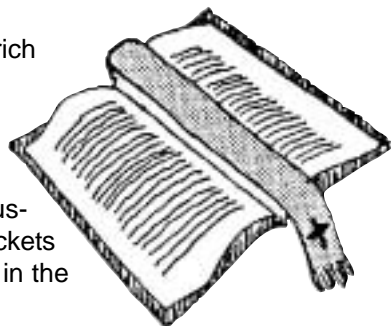

Students explore the eloquent beauty of the liturgical year, the power of prayer, and the Book of Common Prayer so that they see the worship of the Church for all people and all occasions - especially for them!

Choose **Our Faith and Worship** if your parish uses the 1928 USA or the 1962 Canada Book of Common Prayer. If you are using the 1979 USA Book of Common Prayer, choose **The Year of Our Lord** as your course. Either course is a good beginning to a lifetime of faith and faithfulness in the rich Anglican tradition.

Both courses include a Teacher's Manual and Review Question Cards in the **Teacher's Materials**. There are illustrated booklets and Handout Sheet packets which include tests and a Lenten Rule in the **Student Materials** for each course.

Our Sacramental Way

See the great drama of Redemption, from Creation, and the Fall, through the revelations of God to His people, and God's greatest gift, His Son. Learn how the Sacraments each have a part in strengthening us for His service.

This course is divided into two parts. Part One shows the drama of God's work in the world, looking at Creation, how people have cut themselves off from God, and God's revelations, culminating in the greatest gift of all, God made Flesh. Part Two looks at each sacrament, its beginning, its use, and God's strength given to us through the sacraments.

AGE GROUP Ages 9 - 13

The **Teacher's Materials** include the Manual and a set of Review Question cards. The Teacher's Manual is the same for both versions of this course, but the Student Materials are available in either 1979 USA or 1928 USA / 1962 Canada editions. The **Student Materials** include three booklets and a set of handout sheets. The first half of the course uses the booklets entitled God's Mighty Acts in History and Rules of the Road for Christians. The second half uses the booklet Means of Grace. The handout sheets, used throughout the course, include double acrostic puzzles, word puzzles, riddles, a church alphabet puzzle, and tests.

Supplemental courses from Father Karl MarshFor use with **Our Sacramental Way** (see p.8)**AGE GROUP** Ages 8 - Adult**With Our Whole Being****The whole parish can learn “with their whole beings” in this course which coordinates the Sunday School with the worship service.**

Worship outlines provide clergy and lay readers with hymns, psalms, Scripture lesson introductions, Scripture passages, and collects which are the counterpart of the motif of the classroom for the same Sunday. Each of these services can be held according to the usual Sunday schedule. The materials provided in **With Our Whole Being** simply take the place of the hymns, collects, etc. The lessons are written with the assumption that the worship service will precede the education time, but the order can be reversed. Congregations then follow their worship with classes, either in age groups or in family groups. The course can be used in a 14-week terms, covering just the sacraments, or for the whole school year. All instructors and students use the same book.

The Eucharist**An Instructed Eucharist by The Reverend Karl E. Marsh and a Study Eucharist by Dorothy and Tom Teal**

The Instructed Eucharist was developed for use in church, designed to instruct the congregation in the basic actions of the service. Father Marsh recommends that the altar be moved close to the altar rail and that the priest celebrate facing the people so that everyone can see. The Study Eucharist is designed for class use following the service. It goes into greater depth and explains the meaning and use of the ceremonial which is an integral part of the service in many parishes.

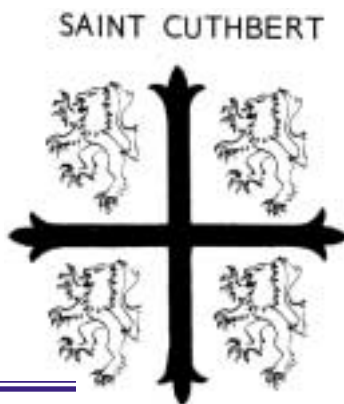

One In Christ

A 10-week course about some amazing British Saints

AGE GROUP Ages 8 - 12

Have you ever heard of Saint Ninian? Or Saint Edmund? Do the children in your classroom know who converted the Scottish King Malcolm to the Christian faith? The Christian courage and stamina, and the devotion to God seen in the lives of these men and women makes for a great study of true heroes.



This course is shorter than most of the Teal Curriculum courses, lasting only for 10 sessions. It could be used as a summer time project, or at any other time when a full course is too much. Included in the **Teacher Materials** is a manual and an Activity Packet which has a chart to be made by the teacher showing the attributes of the Saints, and a map puzzle which becomes a map of England when put together at the end of the sessions. The **Student Materials** is a booklet called One In Christ, containing a map of England, a chart of the Saints studied, a discussion of each Saint, and a final map and border pieces to be removed from the book and assembled.

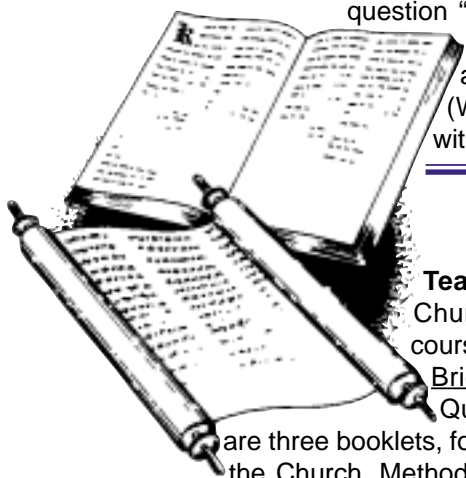

This Is The Church

A challenging course which gives students a chance to defend what they know “in court”

AGE GROUP Ages 12 - Adult

The course is divided into three parts. Part 1 is a review of the basics, a look at the Church Catholic, our responsibilities in it, the origin and content of the Creeds and the Bible, and canon law. Part 2 discusses the question “Why believe?” Part 3 is Christianity put on trial. The students analyze the arguments used against Christianity. (We recommend using this course with a large and active group.)



Teacher Materials for This Is The Church include the manual for the course, A Brief for the Prosecution, A Brief for the Defense, and Review Question Cards. **Student Materials** are three booklets, for classroom and home study (This Is the Church, Methods of Group Discussion, and Sixteen Charges Against Christianity) as well as handout sheets with a comparison of the Creeds, Church organization charts, charts of proofs, tests, etc. Although the details for teaching this course are clearly spelled out, an enthusiastic and creative teacher and class could adapt the various aspects of this course to a variety of situations.

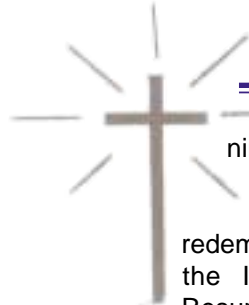

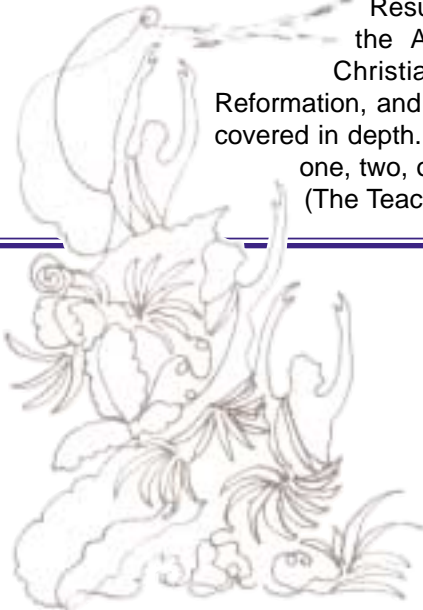
Triumph of the Faith

AGE GROUP Ages Junior High and Up



Beginning before the beginning, with proofs for the existence of God, this comprehensive course covers the whole of the history of redemption. The Pentateuch, Prophets, the Incarnation, Ministry, Crucifixion, Resurrection, and Ascension of our Lord, the Apostolic Age, early heresies, the Christian Year, the Papacy and the Reformation, and the Book of Common Prayer are all covered in depth. The course could easily be used for one, two, or even three full school years. (The Teacher's book has 270 pages in it!)



The **Teacher's Manual** is a thorough and comprehensive sentence-style outline, with footnotes, explanations, and index. In the **Student Text**, the chapters match the Teacher's book, with the main information from each lesson pulled out and illuminated by illustrations and diagrams. Comparisons, charts, lists, and the like are kept by students to refer to in years to come.

Church History in Two Courses**History I: Guided by the Holy Spirit**

The history of the Church on the continent from Pentecost through Vatican II

AGE GROUP Ages Junior High and Up

Best used after the basics of the Christian faith have been taught (Triumph of the Faith is a good course for this) this course in Church History is a good place to go. The history of Anglicanism is referred to, but is not thoroughly taught until History II: The March of Anglicanism. The material is divided into topics rather than into sessions, so that the teacher is free to use the course over more than one year, if desired. Great Saints, damaging heresies, Apostles, popes, and the Age of Enlightenment are all part of this thorough course. (380 pages in the Teacher's Book!) Review questions and answers are included.

The history of the Anglican Church in England and in North America

As in History I, the course is divided into subjects instead of sessions and could be used for more than one year. Again, there are review questions and answers in the Teacher's book. Part 1 begins with "Early History of Briton" and covers material through the Norman Invasion. Part 2 covers the period from William the Conqueror through Oxford Movement. Part 3 begins with the Church in Virginia and discusses events through the Lambeth Quadrilateral. The **Student Materials** for this course include both the text and a timeline entitled "Two Thousand Years."

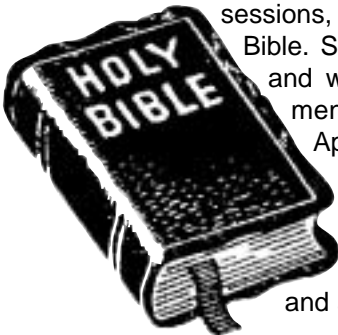
Not So Briefly About the Bible

Not a commentary, but rather a book of study notes for use as a reference guide, compiled by the Teals to aid a class of Bible study. This book could be used by each member of a class, or used by just the teacher in conjunction with other study helps. It is also very flexible, not being written in sessions, but arranged according to the books of the Bible. Supplementing with great art prints, with maps, and with readings from various versions is recommended. Review questions are included. The Appendices contain Geographical Information, a list of Important Characters in the Bible and the books in which they are mentioned, a Glossary of Terms, the Hierarchy of Angels, the Symbolism of Numbers, notes on Translations, and a Timeline of Biblical History.



A moderate view of Higher Criticism is presented in this guide. It may be helpful to the teacher to consult other sources regarding this matter.

Review, Review, and Review

Questions and Answers for the Teal Courses from Kindergarten through History II

The uses for this book of questions are nearly infinite. Here are a few: Study the questions to learn what your class covered last year. Ask your class last year’s questions to enable them to really master the material. Then ask the questions from the year before that!
